From this Camp Meeting, we will go back to our homes and churches ready to play our part, demonstrating to the world that we are truly His disciples. More loving disciples!

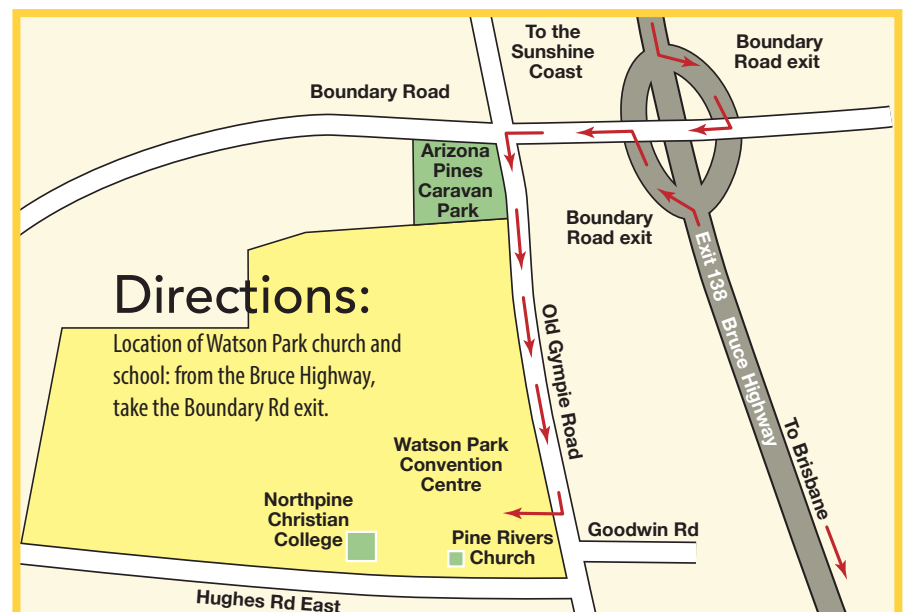
May God grant that it be so.
