

Activity Purchase Cut-off Times

Wristbands must be purchased online prior to the cut-off date listed above.

Activities may be purchased at Camp for an additional charge if:

- The attendee has a pre-purchased wristband; and
- The activities are purchased prior to 12noon the day BEFORE the activity is scheduled

Activity Limits

Some activities have limited places due to venue limitations. Purchase of a wristband only does not guarantee a place in any activity. If you wish to ensure that your child does not miss out, include the activity in this transaction.

Online Transactions

Only one transaction per child is accepted into the Actipass System. If you are wishing to make additions to a processed transaction, please contact the office on 07 3218 7777.

Refund Policy

Refunds will only be given in the event of a child contracting an illness or injury that prevents them from attending. If your child changes their mind they may exchange the activity for another in the same Division if the exchange is completed prior to 12 noon the day before the earliest activity to be exchanged. Please note that for some events an administration fee may be applicable.

Theme Park Annual Passes

Annual passes for theme parks are not valid for use as part of the Big Camp activities.

Wristbands

Your child will be issued with a wristband ("Actipass") which must be worn in order to attend purchased camp activities. If for any reason you have an issue with your child's wristband please bring your child and/or band to the Camp Office.

As the wristbands help to identify your child's emergency record in our database they are not interchangeable between children and **MUST ONLY BE WORN** by the listed attendee in this application.

Consent & safety

By continuing with this application you are providing your consent for your child to attend the selected activities. All required emergency and medical information is collected through this application, including your Medicare and Health Insurance details (where applicable).

An email containing further activity details will be sent out to all wristband holders prior to camp. If you do not receive this email, or if you wish to withdraw your consent, please contact the office as a matter of urgency 07 3218 7777 or sqactipass@adventist.org.au.

Custodial Issues

If your child has a current custody order in place, please contact us on 07 3218 7777 or sqactipass@adventist.org.au to advise. A copy of the order, along with a photo of your child and any further information we should be aware of will be required. A photo ID will be requested when collecting your child.

Medical

If an epi-pen may be required, it must remain with the child at all times. Please talk to the Division Leader if your child has a life-threatening illness and requires assistance. In such cases, a parent/guardian is advised to accompany their child.

Protecting your privacy

Protecting your privacy is important to us. The information we seek allows us to manage risk, provide reasonable care and administer your involvement in our program. We are careful to keep your information confidential, and provide it only to those agents acting on behalf of the organisation who need it to enable them to perform their agreed activities (eg First-Aid Officer). We will not use your information for other purposes. You are welcome to contact our office in relation to issues regarding your personal information and for a copy of our Privacy Policy.

We only ask for information that is necessary for the purposes outlined in this statement. In some circumstances, if you don't provide us with all requested information, you may miss the opportunity to be involved in our program.
