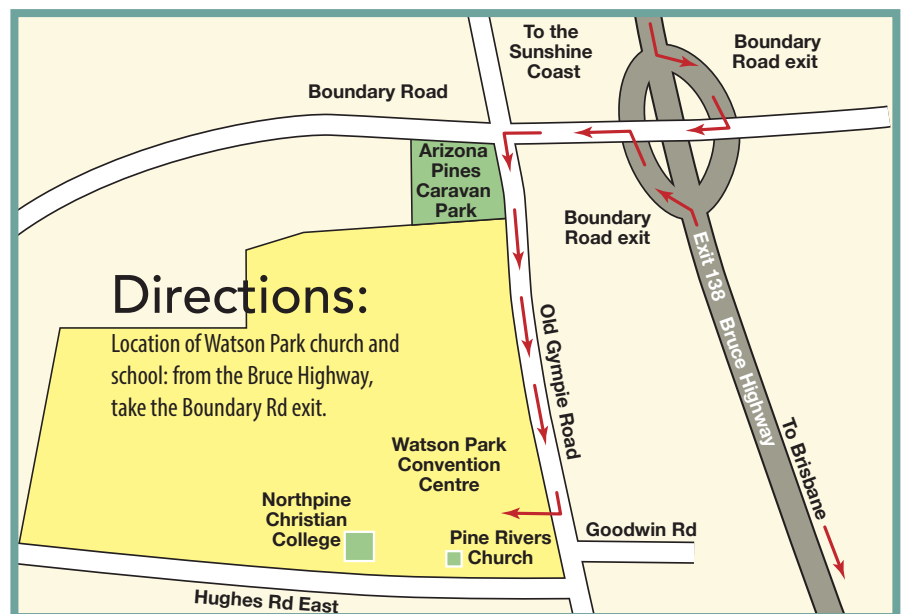

## KEYNOTE SPEAKERS



**Dr Cedric Vine (Big Tent)** is a native of Britain who gained his PhD from the University of Sheffield focussing on the book of Matthew. Dr Vine lectured

at Newbold College in England before moving to Andrews University as Associate Professor of New Testament. Apart from his passion to uphold the authority and role of scripture in a postmodern secular world, it is often said that Cedric has a way of making deep Bible themes accessible to people at all levels. Born into a pastoral family, Dr Vine is married with three boys of his own and brings with him an engaging sense of English humour.



**Pr Shawn Brace (Encounter)** is pastoring in Maine USA, bordering Southeastern Canada. He and his wife Camille have three children - Camden, Acadia, and Winslow

(all named after Maine locations). His ministry has become increasingly focused on mission & discipleship, incarnating the gospel in his city - and teaching and training others to do the same. He is currently transitioning his church to be more missional (people-centred) and less attractional (building and program-centred). Shawn and Camille's podcast, "Mission Lab," ([missionlab.podbean.com](http://missionlab.podbean.com)) tracks this journey of transition.

Shawn has authored three books, most recently *There's More to Jesus* (Signs Publishing), and contributes to various Adventist publications and websites.

As a family that lives all of life centring around mission, Shawn, Camille and their children love to spend time in the outdoors, hiking and enjoying the beauty of Maine, often with their missional community and the friends God has placed in their lives. Shawn also enjoys photography and videography and loves engaging with people.



**Pr Troy Fitzgerald (Youth)** believes the good news of Christ is even better than before! He has been serving as Young Adult Pastor at

Walla Walla University Church, USA, for 20 years. He is married to Julia, and has two sons, Cameron and Morgan. 

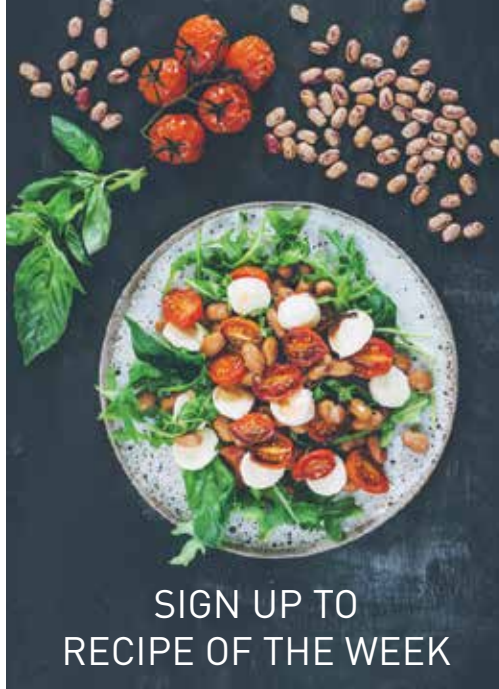
