Dear Church Family,

Queensland State Government announced yesterday an early move to Stage 2 of the [Roadmap to easing Queensland's restrictions](#). This is a result of 5 consecutive days with zero new Coronavirus cases in Queensland. As of Noon today:

*“Queenslanders will be able to undertake **unlimited travel**, including overnight stays throughout the entire state, in a major easing of COVID-19 restrictions.*

*More locals will be allowed in cafés, restaurants, pubs and clubs, with an increase in the number of patrons from 10 to **20**.*

From noon on Friday, June 5, venues with more space will be allowed up to 20 people in each defined area if they follow an approved COVID Safe Industry Plan.”

With this good news, we continue to encourage and support you as you maintain your ministry in the Church.

The South Queensland Conference supports decisions made by both Federal and Local Governments to ease back into a healthy recovery and rebuilding back to usual life, ministry and business. We want to remain a part of the solution and not the problem, and protect our communities from threats of virus outbreaks and second waves, and support the **gradual re-opening of churches**. Our support, services and ministry **remain open and fully operational**.

In line with decisions made by the State Government:

1. Church physical locations may re-open for worship and all church affiliated meetings and activities with **a maximum of 20 people per premises**
 - a. Larger churches can break their services and meetings up, and run them at different times of the day, to meet the 20 person quota
 - b. **Churches must:**
 - i. Follow the recently updated and Adcom approved **SQC230.002.ADM - Church Low Risk Or Common Activities Risk Register** at all times
 - ii. Fully disinfect and clean premises in between gatherings
 - iii. Record attendees contact details and store data securely
 - iv. Keep to 4 square meters per person when indoors
 - v. Physical distancing (1.5-2m)
 - vi. Follow General standard precautions
 - vii. Frequent environmental cleaning and disinfection
2. Sabbath church services may still be accessible online. Please visit your local church website for details
 - a. Church members over 70 years of age are recommended to remain home for church affiliated worships, meetings and activities

3. Members in the church community can gather together in groups of a **maximum of 20 people**, for:
 - a. home group worship and bible studies with a **maximum of 20 visitors** allowed from separate households
 - b. hiking, camping and other recreational activities in national and state parks
 - c. public spaces and lagoons
4. Funerals with a maximum of **50** people
5. Weddings with a maximum of **20** people

While the churches are gradually re-opening, **General Precautionary Standards apply at all times**, which include:

- washing your hands often and thoroughly with regular soap and water for at least 20 seconds
- using a tissue to cover your mouth or cough and sneeze into your elbow
- avoiding close contact with others, such as touching and shaking hands
- Discard used tissues in a bin or bag immediately and wash your hands immediately
- Don't touch your eyes, nose, or mouth with unwashed hands
- Frequently clean and disinfect regularly used surfaces and public areas, such as hand rails, door handles and benches
- Maintain social distance at all times with a distance of at least 1.5 meters between yourself and the next person (for public interactions)
- Stay home, self-quarantine and call your doctor if you feel unwell

Home Gatherings:

- Home owners hosting gathering are expected to ensure homes are cleaned and sanitized
- Maximum of 20 visitors allowed from separate households
- Household members and visitors are to:
 - confirm if they are healthy and no fever
 - maintain 1.5m social distancing
 - follow general precautionary standards listed above

Church service live-streaming and recording:

- Follow the recently updated and Adcom approved **SQC230.002.ADM - Church Low Risk Or Common Activities Risk Register** at all times
- Follow social distancing practice by keeping 1.5m – 2m distance at all times
- Follow General Precautionary Standards listed above
- Frequently clean and disinfect regularly used surfaces and public areas, such as hand rails, door handles and benches
- If hand sanitizers (hand gels or sprays) are not available then wash your hands every 20 minutes (take a break)
- Clean or sanitize any equipment, tools or stationary that is shared between people using sanitizing (alcohol) wipes. Cleaning and sanitizing must be done each time before a new person uses these items:
 - Microphones
 - Headsets/ head pieces/ ear pieces

- Pens, clip boards, folders
- Electronic screens, mobile phones, ipads or anything similar
- Other electronic equipment that may be used
- Sanitize (with spray and wipe bottle or wet wipes) shared surfaces. Cleaning and sanitizing must be done each time before a new person touches or uses these items:
 - Tables and or benches
 - Chairs
 - Hand rails and door knobs

Tithes and Offerings

Currently, churches are encouraged to give via the flexible tithe and offerings as outlined:

- Access to Electronic Giving (e-giving) via the internet website
- Access to e-giving by the new APP that can be easily downloaded to your mobile phone and/or ipad
- Details on Manal Credit Card Sheet that can be completed and emailed to us to allow for giving via credit or debit cards
- Access to Phone Service, should you wish to phone your credit card details through for our staff to assist you in your tithes and offerings
- Details for Direct Bank Transfers to our Conference bank account, should you prefer to give in this way
- Details on a personal Deposit system, available here at our Administration and Resourcing Centre (Spring Hill)
- Details on Mail Delivery for giving donations

For churches who wish to take up tithes and offerings at church, place offering boxes or baskets in convenient places, so members can leave their offerings without handling an offering bag that others have handled.

Treasurers who are counting and handling cash must wash their hands thoroughly after contact with cash.

The Crisis Management Team has heard and considered concerns raised by churches regarding the re-opening of church premises and facilities, and will guide churches in the plan for the gradual re-opening.

Convention Centers / Camp sites

The centers will now be open for Family camping, Caravan and Accommodation options to group sizes of maximum of 20 people* (Stage 2 of the roadmap).

The Centers and camp sites will open up on **10th June 2020** for Church, School and Group Camping and Caravan and accommodation options to group sizes of maximum 100 people*. Following social distancing measures on 1 person per 4 square meters for each of the accommodation facilities, dining and meeting halls (Stage 3 of the roadmap).

(* Unless Government social distancing exemptions are applied to the hirer).
